

The Strange Baal Circles around Nashville Baptist College

The Word of God refers again and again to man's imagination and its dark propensity for evil. Around 2400 BC our heavenly Father destroyed virtually all life on earth because of this: **"And GOD saw that the wickedness of man was great in the earth, and that every imagination of the thoughts of his heart was only evil continually."** (Genesis 6:5)

One reason the darkness of this world is not obvious to most Christians is the physical comfort that so many still enjoy. Despite the prevailing spiritual decay all around us, the professing church continues to focus only on microscopic islands of righteousness and to ignore the great continent of wickedness on which our civilization rests. Christ referred to this in the Book of Revelation when he addressed the church of Laodicea. His scorching rebuke applied, not only to the local church in Laodicea at that time, but to the final phase of church history in which we now live:

"Because thou sayest, I am rich, and increased with goods, and have need of nothing; and knowest not that thou art wretched, and miserable, and poor, and blind, and naked:" (Revelation 3:17)

The blindness in question is very real. Since most pastors and ministers are afflicted by it, its looming presence is largely ignored. How can the LORD heal a condition which the pastors themselves refuse to acknowledge? When blind Bartimaeus approached Jesus with his loud appeals, the Lord asked him what he wanted. We would have thought this was obvious, but Jesus wanted the man to declare that he was blind. Only then would he heal him.

The church today is determined to hide from its own blindness. Its leaders feel their way along with outrageous self-confidence, pretending to discern the will of God while shamefully ignoring the plainly stated commandments set out in His Word.

Ireland is about to hold a referendum – a national plebiscite or popular vote – to decide whether or not, under certain circumstances, unborn children should be killed. Despite the obvious moral and spiritual obscenity being foisted on the people of Ireland by a corrupt government, our 'Christian' ministers and pastors, collectively, are completely silent!

In August 2017 we wrote to 124 ministers and pastors of Bible-believing churches in Ireland, offering to host a one-day seminar in Dublin where church leaders could discuss and agree details of a campaign to resist what the government was trying to do. Only three replied.

We wrote again recently to the same ministers and pastors – Presbyterian, Evangelical, Methodist, Baptist, Pentecostal, Nazarene – repeating our offer. How many replied? Not one.

Abrogation of responsibility

From numerous enquiries we have made, we know that no initiative of any kind is planned by the church in Ireland to deal seriously with the threatened legalization of abortion-for-convenience in this country. It matters not to these pastors and ministers that a regime similar to that in the UK could soon be operating in this country if the 8th Amendment – which grants equal rights to the mother and her unborn child – is repealed. The UK routinely kills late-term children in the womb who are known to have Down syndrome or some other debilitating condition.

It is just as Jesus said: "...and knowest not that thou art wretched, and miserable, and poor, and blind, and naked." The majority of ministers and pastors in Ireland are blind to the fact that they have locked out Christ and follow instead an idol fashioned after their own imagination.

Grievous Wolves

This introduction may seem unrelated to the title of this paper, but the situation at the American Baptist College in Nashville, Tennessee, and the situation in Ireland are all part of the same blindness. Those who choose not to see are as 'blind' as those who can't see. The blight is so serious that one must ask whether the ministry on both sides of the Atlantic includes substantial numbers of pastors and preachers whose allegiance to the church is non-existent, individuals who have been placed there by the Enemy to undermine Biblical Christianity and advance the goals of Ecumenism, 'unity' and the New World Order.

The Church of Rome boasted long ago that it would do just that! The Jesuits have for generations trained their agents to serve as impeccable Baptist pastors and Evangelical preachers. By this well-honed duplicity they have infiltrated the Bible-believing church and taken control of countless influential positions. This is why seemingly well-grounded, Bible-believing leaders can suddenly espouse the spirit and false doctrines of Rome.

As leaders *within* the church of Christ, they are able, like "**grievous wolves**," to steer their unsuspecting flocks in whatever direction they choose and introduce all kinds of practices to promote an ecumenical mindset – the *Alpha Course*, the *Walk to Emmaus*, contemplative spirituality, the eucharistic presence, the teachings of the so-called Church Fathers, mystical and ascetic prayer and reflection, inter-faith services, inter-faith hymns, sentimental rituals, the social gospel, watered-down Bible translations, and so forth.

The American Baptist College

The *Wikipedia* entry on the American Baptist College states:

Baptist World Center

Dedicated in 1989, the Baptist World Center was constructed as a state-of-the-art Official International Headquarters for the National Baptist Convention USA, Inc. It is the very first building of its kind erected by the convention. The Baptist World Center is located on the south edge of the [Nashville] campus, on the original site of the former National Baptist Missionary Training center. It houses administrative offices of the National Baptist Convention, USA, Inc. and is used by American Baptist College for classroom space, events, workshops, and the campus dining hall. The sanctuary is large enough to accommodate the Annual Mid-Winter Board Meeting of the National Baptist Convention USA, Inc., as well as annual lectures and major conferences and convocations of the college.

Our analysis shows that the specially constructed, state-of-the-art building which they mention is surrounded by a series of Baal circles, including 9 in which both obelisks in the set are at least 40ft tall. In fact, six of them are among the 30 tallest obelisks in North America.

Table A below lists the circles we have identified, where the center in every case is the state-of-the-art building occupied by the American Baptist College in Nashville, Tennessee. It comprises 13 concentric circles (or 'mile-wide rings') defined by a pair of obelisks along their circumference.

The geographical co-ordinates for each of the above may be found in **Appendix A**.

Could this happen by chance?

Could this happen by chance? To answer this we need to know how many obelisks of significant size are dotted across America and southern Canada. We list in **Appendix A** the obelisks we know to be 40ft tall or more. They were identified via geographical websites such as *waymarking.com* and *geograph.com*, as well as war memorial websites and websites listing notable monuments in each state.

The total geographical area we are considering lies east of the Rockies and forms a circle with a radius of about five hundred miles around Nashville. This means there is space for about 500 'mile wide rings' [Our previous papers show that each of these Babylonian 'rings' or 'circles' has a perimeter a mile wide]. The odds that any ring would have an obelisk at least 40ft tall is therefore 1 in 5 (There are about 100 obelisks of this size east of the Rockies). Therefore the odds that the American Baptist College should have 9 such rings is 5^9 (5 to the power of 9) or nearly 1 in 2 million.

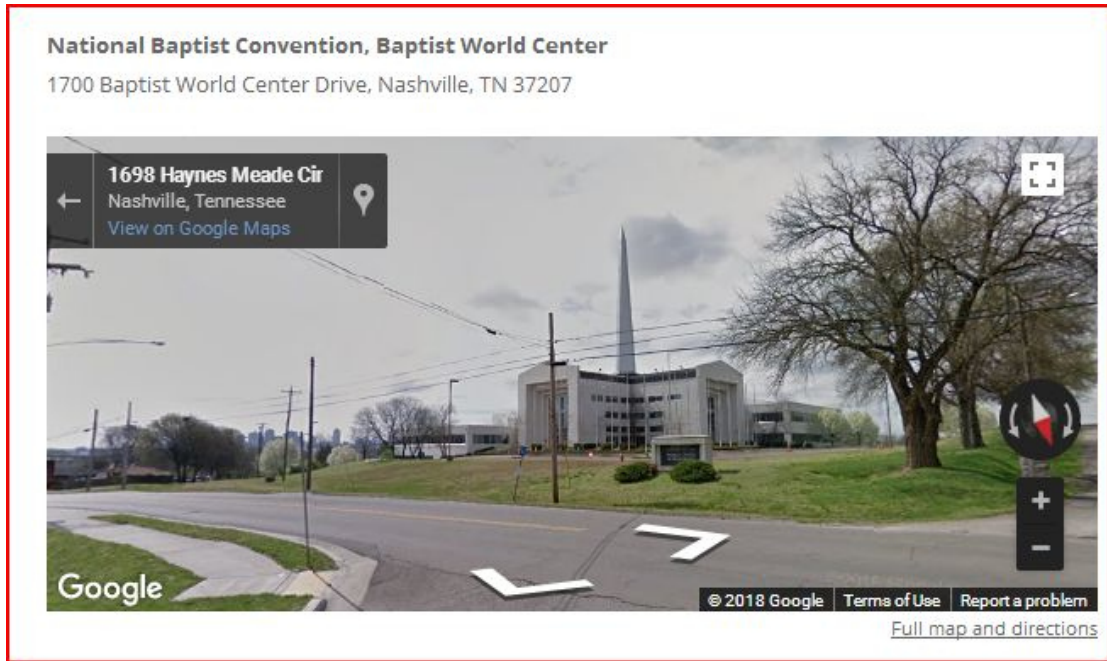
So did it happen by chance? Of course not.

But there's more.

The photo of the American Baptist College shown at the start of this paper is the same one displayed on its own official website [www.abcnash.edu/]. It seems innocent enough, right? But why is a tree obscuring part of the building?



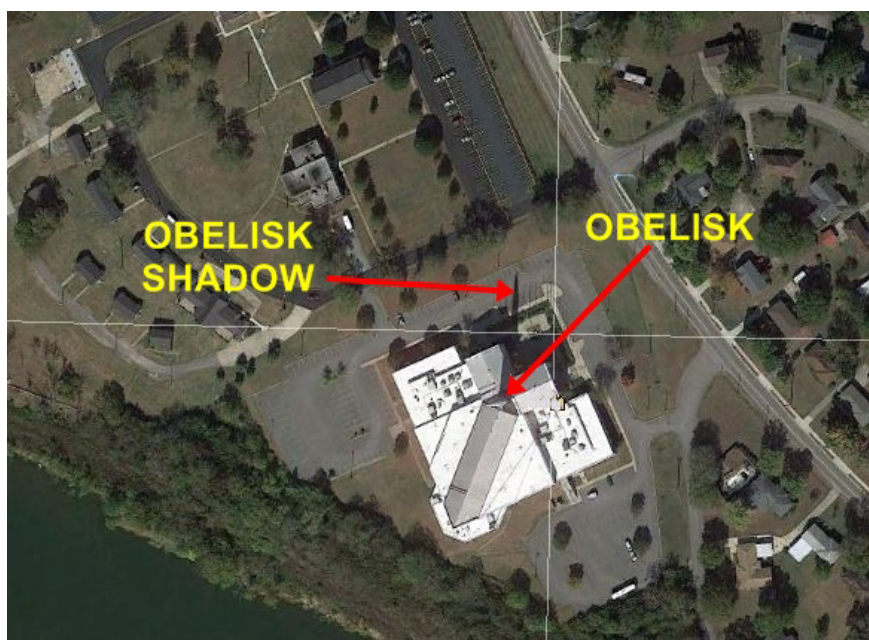
There are no other photos on the website that show the complete building. In fact photos of the building are not easy to find on the Internet. However, if we go into Google's 'Streetview' service and take a tour around the campus, we can see what the website photo was designed to conceal:



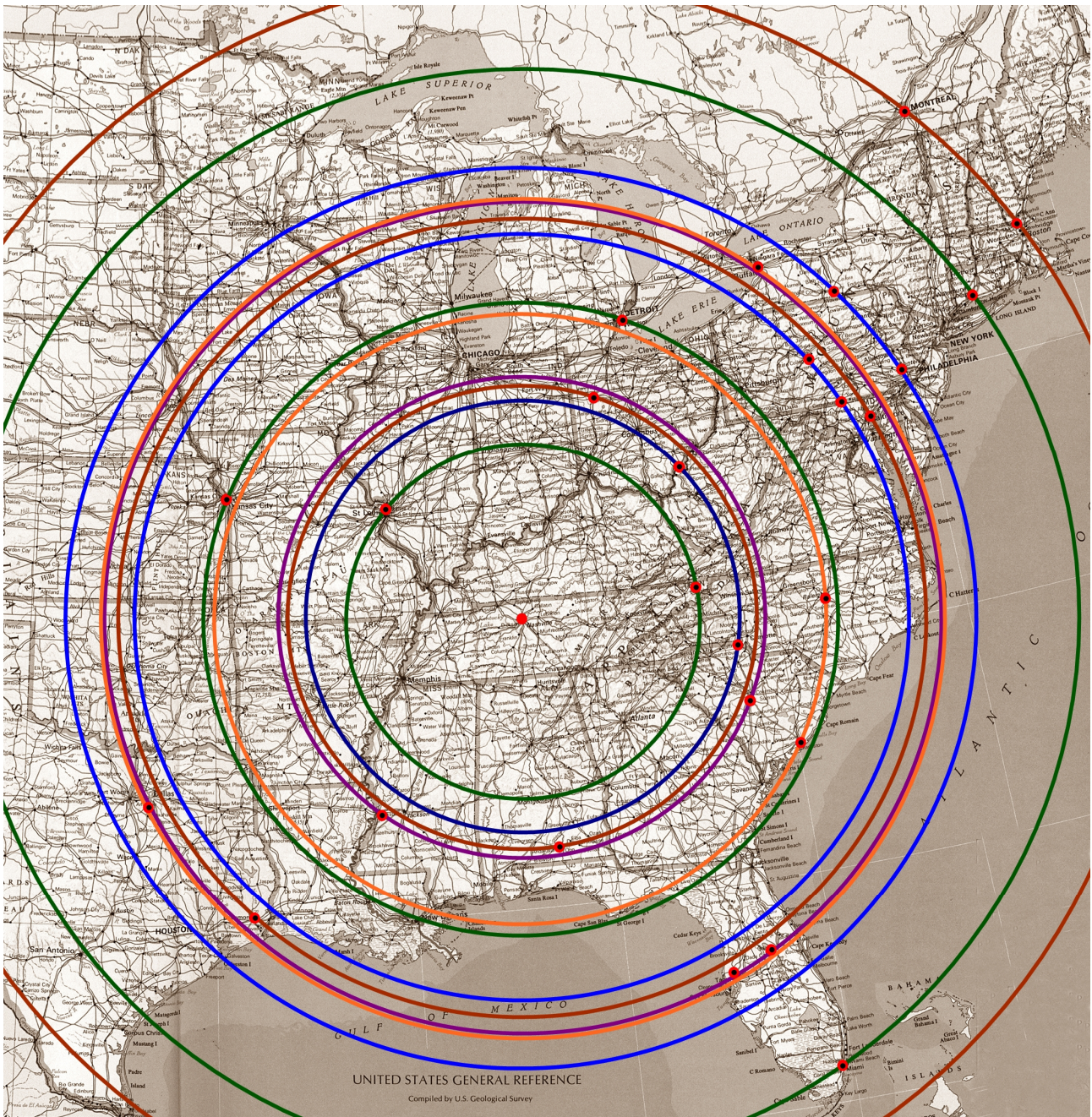
Ah yes, another obelisk! And not just an obelisk on the campus grounds, but an obelisk located right at the heart of the building. It looks like it might be 80ft tall, if not taller.

In all our research into the bizarre occult world of obelisks and the strange people who construct them, we have never found an instance like this. It takes extraordinary arrogance to place an obelisk inside a public building! How much more so, then, when that building is supposedly dedicated to the work of Christ. This was clearly intended to blaspheme the LORD God of Israel.

Where are the Bible-believing Christians in America today? Has it not occurred to anyone that this building, with its idolatrous obelisk, is an abomination?

This map is intended only to illustrate the evidence set out in Table A.

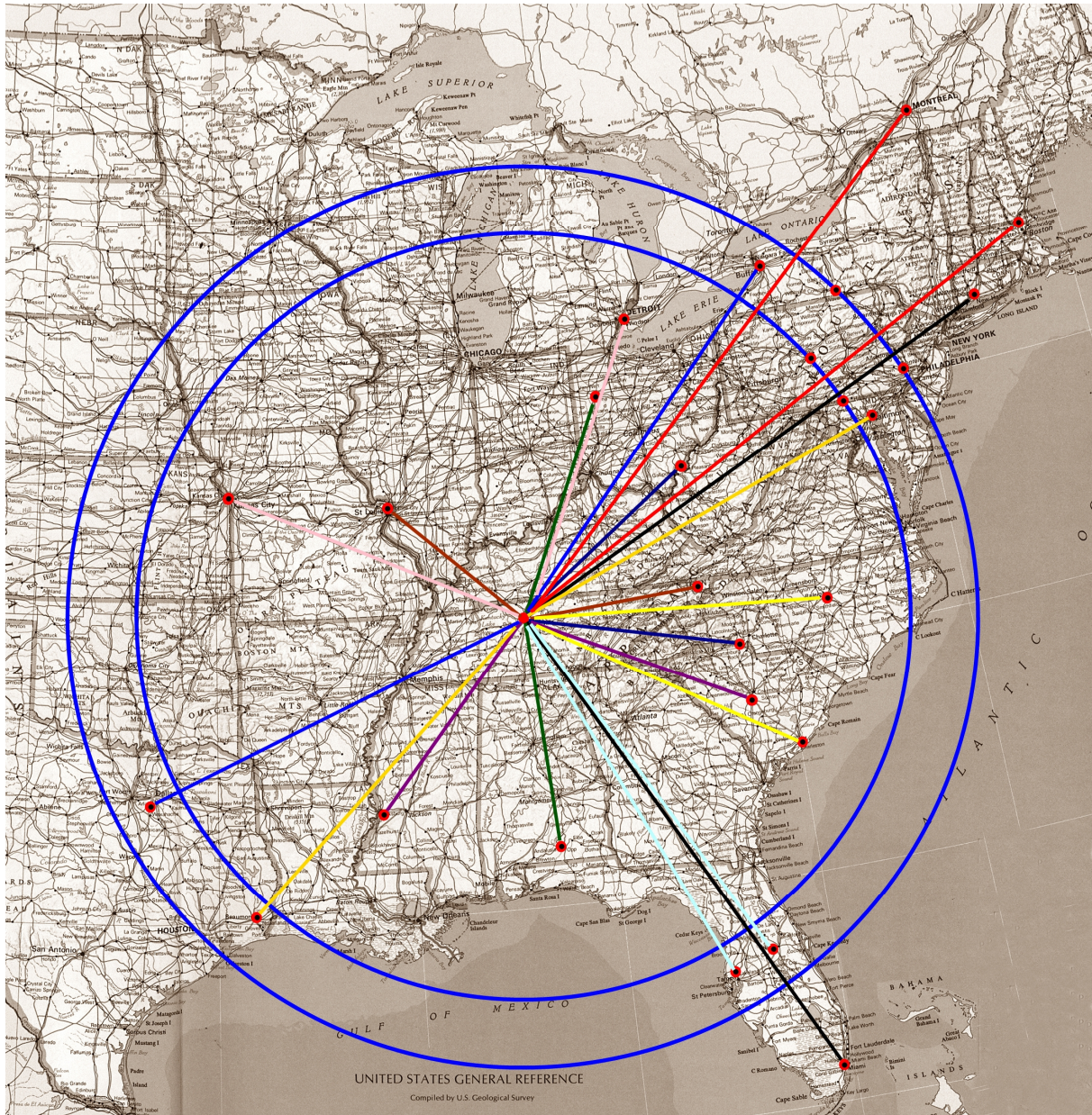


Chart showing Nashville as the 'Sun' at the center of the 'Solar System', around which the gods orbit in submissive obedience to their Celestial Master. If it looks similar to the *solar system* as depicted in classroom charts, it is because the solar system itself is simply a Babylonian fiction based on Baal Circles. In reality, the earth is flat and stationary and countless millions of times larger than the sun – just as the Bible teaches. This means the so-called solar system does not exist! It is nothing but a wicked deception devised by the Babylonian Elite to attack the Word of God and destroy humanity's trust in the Bible. As a result most people today believe many of the lies about 'outer space', 'alien civilizations', 'other forms of life', and the possibility of 'other earth-like planets'. This is all part of the great End Time deception. The same people who built the Baal Circles also built NASA. Their god is Apollo (who is also known as Osiris, Helios, Baal, etc).

The Worship of Baal

The worship of Baal in Biblical times involved the cutting and preparation of a wooden pole or tree stock, erecting it in the center of a sacred zone or grove, and decorating it with silver and gold foil, along with other types of ornamentation:

"They that sanctify themselves, and purify themselves in the gardens behind one *tree* in the midst, eating swine's flesh, and the abomination, and the mouse, shall be consumed together, saith the LORD."

- Isaiah 66:17

The word "tree" in the KJV does not occur in the original Hebrew but was added by the translators, as indicated by their use of italics. They are correct in using this interpretation, though it could also refer to a stone idol.

Note the word 'midst' in the verse from Isaiah (underlined). The word for 'midst' in Hebrew is **tâvek** (H8432). Strong defines it as follows:

H8432 tâvek, taw'-vek; from an unused root meaning to sever; a bisection, i.e. (by implication) the centre: (Strong)

Gesenius is even clearer: "the middle of a thing, so called from its being divided."

The idol stood in the midst or middle of the grove, as such it occupied the center, which is a key concept in the Babylonian religion. Lucifer, the sun god, always wants to occupy the center.

The Word of God goes on to describe for our benefit, in the book of Jeremiah, the way this idol was prepared:

"For the customs of the people are vain: for one cutteth a tree out of the forest, the work of the hands of the workman, with the axe. They deck it with silver and with gold; they fasten it with nails and with hammers, that it move not. They are upright as the palm tree, but speak not: they must needs be borne, because they cannot go. Be not afraid of them; for they cannot do evil, neither also is it in them to do good...

But they are altogether brutish and foolish: the stock is a doctrine of vanities. Silver spread into plates is brought from Tarshish, and gold from Uphaz, the work of the workman, and of the hands of the founder: ...

Every man is brutish in his knowledge: every founder is confounded by the graven image: for his molten image is falsehood, and there is no breath in them. They are vanity, and the work of errors: in the time of their visitation they shall perish.

- Jeremiah 10:3-5, 8-9, 14-15

The word "stock" (underlined) should be noted [Strong's H6086 – '*ets*']. Gesenius defines it as follows -

עץ plur. עצים, const. עצי m.—(1) *a tree* (Arabic عصا a staff, a bone; compare the Gr. ὄζος, a branch, and ὄστρον (Sanc. *asthi*), Lat. *hasta*. For *wood* there is commonly used in Arabic the cognate form عود.
 Hebr. עץ follows the analogy of the verb עצץ to be hard, firm. Chald. with the letters softened, has עץ wood). עץ חיים tree of life (see חיים), Gen. 2:9. Often collect. *trees*. עץ פרי fruitbearing trees, Gen. 1:11.
 (2) wood, specially of a wooden post, stake, gibbet, Gen. 40:19; Deu. 21:22; Josh. 10:26; used of a wooden idol, Jer. 2:27. Pl. עצים *wood*, sticks, logs for fuel, Gen. 22:3, 9; Lev. 1:7; 4:12; used of materials for building, Ex. 25:10; 1 Ki. 6:23, 31, 32. Compare עצץ No. 1.

The stock is equivalent to what we understand today as an obelisk or sacred pillar. Pagans believed they made contact with the gods through their worship of this idol, crafted by their own hands. The priests of Ancient Egypt indulged in this practice in grand style, a practice which is perpetuated today through the religion of Freemasonry. Members of the lower degrees appear to have only a cursory understanding of what the obelisk actually signifies, but those in the higher degrees know better.

**"Then did Solomon build an high place for Chemosh, the abomination of Moab, in the hill that is before Jerusalem, and for Molech, the abomination of the children of Ammon."
 – 1 Kings 11:7**

The obelisk is a phallic symbol representing the sun and the male organ of generation. It is in essence an obscene celebration of Lucifer and his supernatural power. This god is also known as Osiris, Apollo or Helios, whose divine emanations are believed to bathe mankind in the same way that the sun's rays illuminate the earth. Thus Freemasonry is a solar cult devoted to the worship and veneration of the sun god, Osiris.

Unfruitful works of darkness

The Word of God condemns this false religion – "**the unfruitful works of darkness**" – and exhorts all born-again Christians to do likewise. Edmond Ronayne, who by the grace of God escaped the clutches of Freemasonry, condemned these idolatrous works as follows:

...the Apostle Paul, alluding to this same *phallic* worship, speaks of it in terms of the highest reprobation, when he advises the Ephesian Christians to "have no fellowship with the unfruitful works of darkness, but rather reprove them. For," said he, "it is a shame to speak of the things that are done of them in secret." (Ephesians v. 11, 12.) And yet notwithstanding all this, the ministers of our churches – those who claim to be commissioned by the Lord Jesus Christ, to preach the gospel of the grace of God, and to lead men from darkness to light, and the very representatives of that same Apostle Paul – these men I say go into those dark dens of infamy and sin, called Masonic lodges, join themselves to this very same Baal-peor, solemnly swear to maintain and support the wicked religious philosophy of which it forms an important part, use whatever influence they possess in inducing others to follow their example, and when questioned on the subject by even one of their own congregation, they either give a haughty, defiant reply, or else positively lie to hide their wickedness.

- *The Master's Carpet*, p.328

As Worshipful Master in an influential Masonic Lodge in Chicago, Ronayne would have seen and met many of these so-called Christian ministers and pastors during their attendance at Masonic meetings and rituals. They preached Christ in the church but secretly worshipped Baal.

He was writing in the 1870s, but this wicked practice still continues today. This is why the Southern Baptist Convention is such a corrupt organization. It is controlled by the so-called grandmasters of Freemasonry, the devious and deceitful ones who pretend to love the LORD and His Son, Christ Jesus, but secretly serve and worship Baal.

So it is no wonder that one of the most important institutions for promoting true Biblical Christianity in the United States should brazenly display, at its very heart, a massive idol to Baal, or that it should be located at the center of a series of concentric Baal Circles.

"Be not afraid of them"

For all his cleverness, the Enemy has no power over true believers. He can make as many cunning circles as he likes, and erect as many massive obelisks as he likes, but they will make no difference! The true believer is protected from all of this wickedness. Remember the words of Jeremiah which we have just quoted, **"Be not afraid of them; for they cannot do evil, neither also is it in them to do good."** (Jeremiah 10:5)

By exposing these obscenities, we are also exposing the dark duplicity behind them, the true intentions of those who profess to believe God's Word but who are, in reality, sworn servants of Baal. Unless we can recognize these "grievous wolves" and discern their poisonous plan, we will be led further and further into the great End Time deception that will culminate, perhaps sooner than we think, in the arrival of the Antichrist.

Those who serve Baal are indifferent to the evils of abortion. After all, the shedding of innocent blood is a major component in the worship of Moloch – which is just another name for Baal.

The people of Ireland bowed to Baal and his earthly servants in 2001 when they consented to the installation of a massive Baal obelisk in their capital city, the so-called Millennium Spire – one of the tallest Baal shafts in the world. They took another major step along the path of darkness when they voted in favor of homosexual 'marriage' in 2015. And they now appear set to condemn tens of thousands of unborn children to death for social convenience.

The obelisk can do neither evil nor good. But wherever it is found, we know the servants of Baal are snidely proclaiming their supremacy, their secret confederacy, and their determination to undermine and destroy Christianity.

We can expect more and more obelisks and pyramids to be installed in public places in the years ahead, along with other symbols and tokens of Egyptian religion.

His followers, who have hidden themselves so well for so long, would seem to be advertising their philosophy – and their dark ambition – with more vigor and more audacity than ever before. A few weeks ago the Freemasons in the UK took out full-page ads in the leading newspapers – *The Times*, *The Guardian*, and *The Telegraph* – to declare that they would no longer tolerate criticism of their fraternity.

Their warning was very plain, 'Enough Is Enough'. It read in part: "The United Grand Lodge of England believes that the ongoing gross misrepresentation of its 200,000 plus members is discrimination. Pure and simple. We owe it to our membership to take this stance, they shouldn't have to feel undeservedly stigmatised. No other organisation would stand for this and nor shall we."
